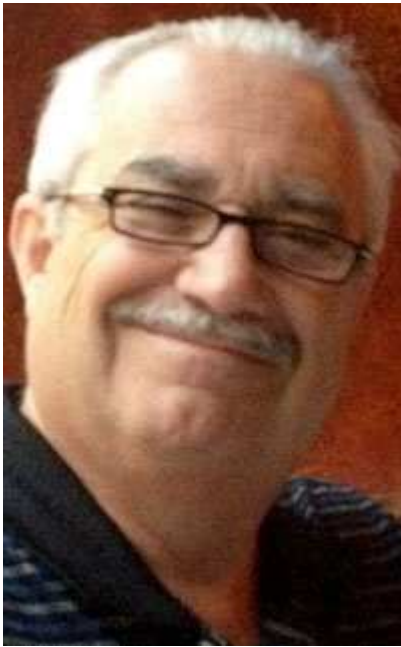


Hutton, Timothy Jack | 1949-2013

Timothy Jack Hutton, 64, an area resident for 31 years, died Friday, Aug. 23, 2013, at his home after a short battle with cancer.
