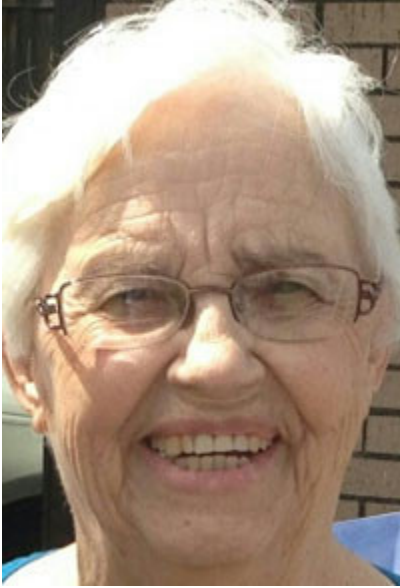


Hester Rosetta Jennings | 1936-2016
