Mr. Moody was best known for being the proprietor of Moody's Paint & Body Shop on Highway 101 in Bridgeport, Texas. After selling the body shop, Robert, an entrepreneur, became the owner of FastFab Metal Buildings where he and his son JR constructed metal buildings throughout Wise County and the DFW metroplex. During this time, and as an active member of the community, Robert served as a member of the Bridgeport City Council for several years.

He married Carolyn Malcolm, the love of his life, in 1968, who survives him. Robert is also survived by daughter Robin Schagren of Highland Village, Texas, sons Robert "JR" Moody and fiancé Bobbie Schwartz of Lake Bridgeport, Texas and Sam Holmes and wife Tricia of Plano, Texas.
