


Sowell, Sidney Nelson 'Sid'

December 17, 1936 ~ August 20, 2022 (age 85)

Sidney (Sid) Nelson Sowell was born in Carlton, Texas on December 17, 1936, and passed away from this world into the arms

of his heavenly Father in Fort Worth, Texas on Saturday, August 20, 2022.
