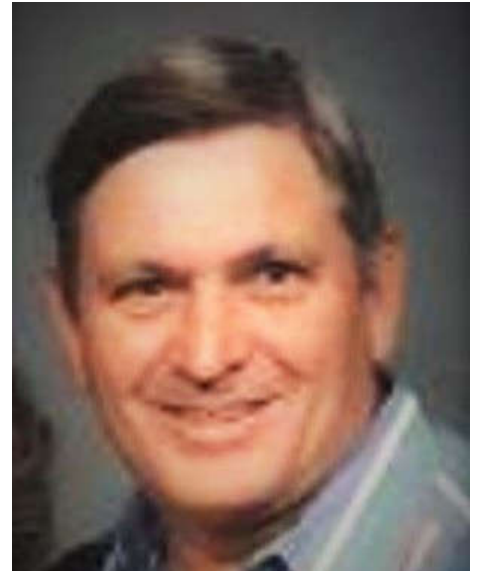




Chilton, Buddy Jack
