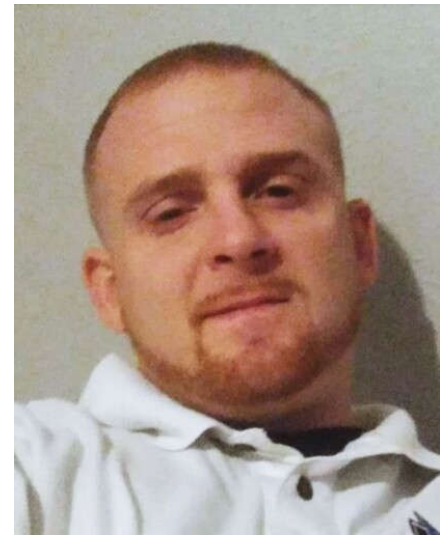




Clay, Ryan Matthew
