

Conley, Gary 'Pappy' Nevon 1940-2023

Gary "Pappy" Nevon Conley, 82, of Denton, passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, Oct. 2, 2023. Gary was born Nov. 12, 1940, to Melba Joe Coffman and Francis G. Conley in Cottondale. He was a graduate of Boyd High School and attended Tarrant County Junior College. He served his country as a Radio Intercept Analysis Operator in the U.S. Air Force, stationed in Okinawa and San Antonio. He married Lynda Bostick on Dec. 22, 1962, in Fort Worth. Together, they raised three children, countless furbabies, and took great pride in their four grandchildren.

Gary was always a hard worker. At times, he held down multiple jobs, working in the food service, retail and technology industries. His last job was the one he enjoyed the most as a cashier for Walmart Neighborhood Market. The cashier job was something he aspired to

return to after he "beat cancer."
