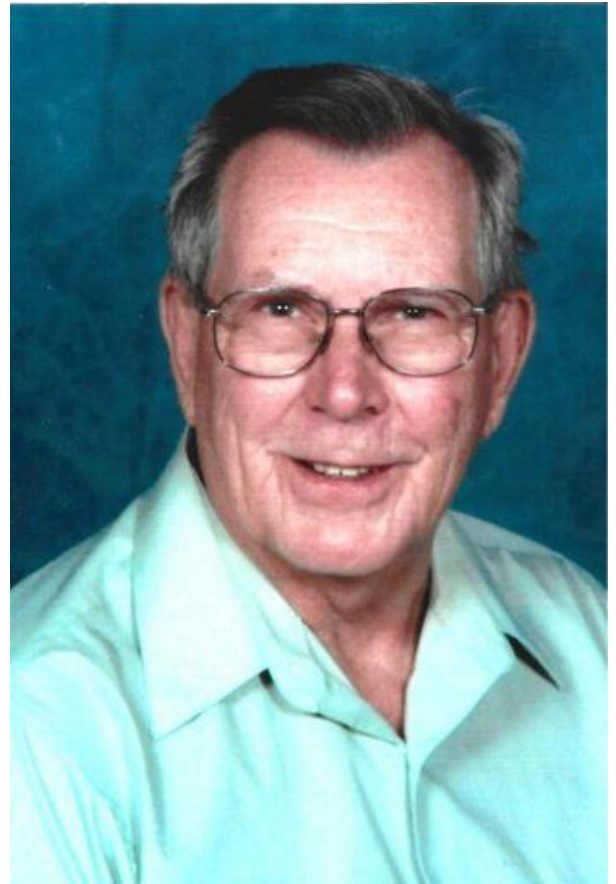




Kujak, Kenneth Joseph
