

Playing cards was his next favorite retirement activity. He loved to be around his friends and drink a beer or two. His nickname, because it was his favorite word to say (although not exactly appropriate), was "Da*n-it Don!" He also loved to watch bull riding, whether it be in person or on TV, and loved his Texas Rangers.

Don is survived by his wife of 40 years, Jackie, of Nocona, Texas; brother Bill and wife Donna; children Donna Bilbrey, Phil Montgomery, Karen McLeroy and husband Dane, and Mandi Osborne; grandkids Misty, Brian, Megan, Lauren, and Kalei; six great-grandkids; one great-great granddaughter; and two nephews.
