Derrell was the man who wore the Texaco star. Serving the community at the station for over 30 years, he was known to bring you a battery, or come to your house to change a flat, if needed. When the fire siren sounded, and no volunteers were available, he would close up and go get on the fire truck. He was affectionally called the "Mayor of Paradise" before it was incorporated. He will be missed by all who knew his blunt honesty, humorous stories, and dependable spirit. Derrell and Margaret had four children together, including son, Kyle Smith of Bridgeport; daughters, Patti Seckman and husband, Cole of Haslet, Pam Martin and Jim Stegman of Paradise and Monica Munn and husband, Bret of Paradise.
