JE Statham, 93, of Grapevine, Texas passed from this earth Tuesday, July 30th, 2024 in Decatur, Texas.

JE "Jay" Statham was born January 1st, 1931 to James E. and Bell (Braswell) Statham in Rockmart, Georgia. He proudly served our country in the United States Navy for over 22 years, having been awarded over 6 medals including the Purple Heart during his service and he retired as a Chief Warrant Officer 2. He spent over 10 years following his Navy Retirement in the Military Sealift Command. Jay was active in the Korean War, Vietnam War, the Gulf War (Desert Storm & Desert Shield). During his time in the Navy, much of it serving at Sea, Jay was able to travel to every continent on our planet, making many dear friends across the world. Jay settled in Grapevine, Tx in 1977 following his retirement from the Navy and he remained in and around this part of North Texas for the remainder of his life (while not at sea).
