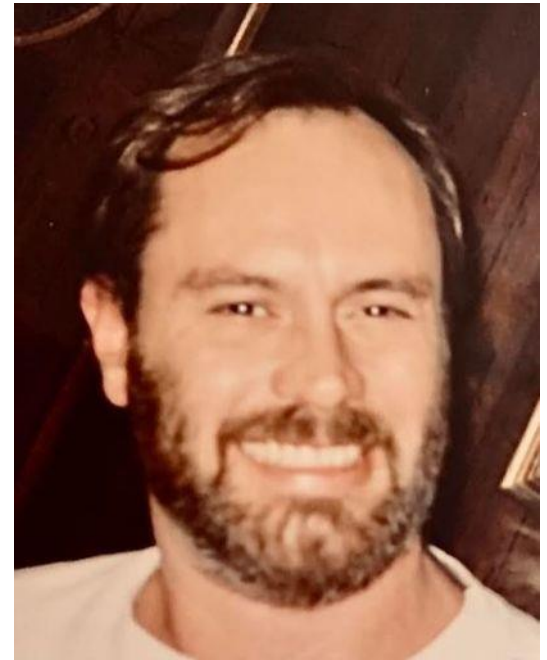




**Wilkins, Curt**
