

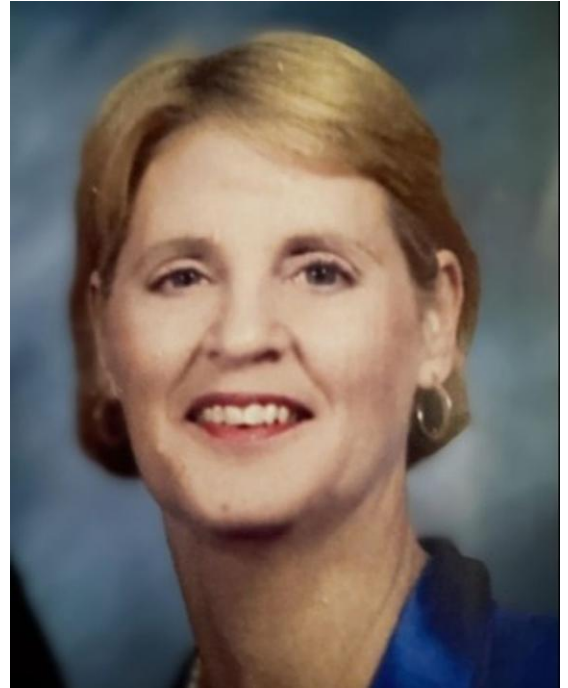


***Carter, Cynthia 'Cindy' Faye (Harrison)***
